New Bus Boarding Procedure for Secondary Students

Fargo Public Schools will be implementing a new safety and accountability measure for all **middle and high school students** who ride district buses.

Beginning Monday, October 27, 2025, students will be required to scan their school ID card or enter their student ID number (lunch number) when boarding the bus to and from school.

To help students prepare, schools will share reminders and information during the week of **October 20–24**.

Why the Change?

This new procedure is being introduced to improve safety, communication, and efficiency across the district's transportation system.

• Enhanced Safety and Security:

Scanning IDs provides real-time information on which students are riding each bus and when they board or exit. This data can be vital in emergencies, helping ensure every student is accounted for.

• Parental Peace of Mind:

Through the **Here Comes the Bus** app, parents can receive notifications showing when and where their child boards or exits the bus—providing reassurance that their child has arrived safely.

• Efficient Bus Management:

The system helps the district and bus operators monitor ridership, adjust routes, and improve scheduling accuracy based on actual student use.

How It Works

Each student receives a **school ID card with a barcode** when school photos are taken. Students can either scan this card or manually enter their student ID number when getting on or off the bus.

- **Morning Trips:** Students will scan or key in when **boarding** the bus. Upon arrival at school, the bus driver will perform a quick walk-through to confirm all students have exited—saving time at drop-off.
- **Afternoon Trips:** Students must scan or key in **both when boarding and exiting** the bus at the end of the day.
