The Board of Education unanimously (4/0) moved to approve the following:

1. Emergency Remediation of Gymnasium Floors

**WHEREAS**, on July 2 and July 31, 2025, the School District's architect and environmental consultant investigated the gymnasiums (which, for purposes of this resolution, includes the high school auxiliary gymnasium and middle school top and bottom gymnasiums), and

**WHEREAS**, the architect and environmental consultant have advised the School District that the floors in the Gymnasiums contain mercury and pose a potential hazard to the safety and welfare of the students and staff if the condition is not remediated; and

**WHEREAS**, the remediation of the floors in the Gymnasiums is required to preserve the health and safety of the students and staff in the building and to preserve the building.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Education declares the remediation of the floors in the Gymnasiums to be an emergency; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Board of Education authorizes said remediation work as an ordinary contingent expense and authorizes the Superintendent of Schools, or her designee, to take the necessary legal steps to perform said remediation.
