Dr. Doeschner, Superintendent of Schools, started her update by answering questions presented to the Board of Education and administration from the July 23, 2025, meeting.

The Superintendent of Schools continued her report with sharing photos via a PowerPoint presentation of the Extended School Year K-8 Program. Dr. Doeschner went over each slide with an explanation of the activities that the students were involved in.
