- A. IDA Report-District weekly door checks.
 - **Region 7 is no longer providing the District with prior notice of IDAs**
 - **Officers will continue to do daily door checks and enter them weekly into Sentinel**
 - **Interior door policy enforced with 1st, 2nd, and 3rd offense penalties**
- B. Stop the Bleed- update
 - **Will certify every 2 years**
 - **All District employees will get certified during the 25-26 school year**
 - **STB will also be included in vector training**
 - **STB kits ordered for new MS**
- C. Traffic Safety Panther Crossing @ schoolhouse
 - **Prepared for additional traffic issues with District construction**
 - **Removal of ES/PS center drive may cause additional delays**
 - **Meeting scheduled with City of Bullard and BPD for 1st day of school traffic concerns**
 - **Gates at ES/PS scheduled to remain open later for 1st 3 days of school**
 - **Plans in place for future parent pick-up/drop-off at MS to be behind the campus in format similar to BEC**
- D. CRG Campus mapping- Multi Agency exercise (7/17/25)
 - **All updated mapping completed and paid for with Cycle 1 grant money**
 - **New MS and updates to ES/PS will be done once all construction is completed**
 - **CRG and multi-agency Active Threat Training was a success with live mapping and camera features working well with SC Dispatch**
