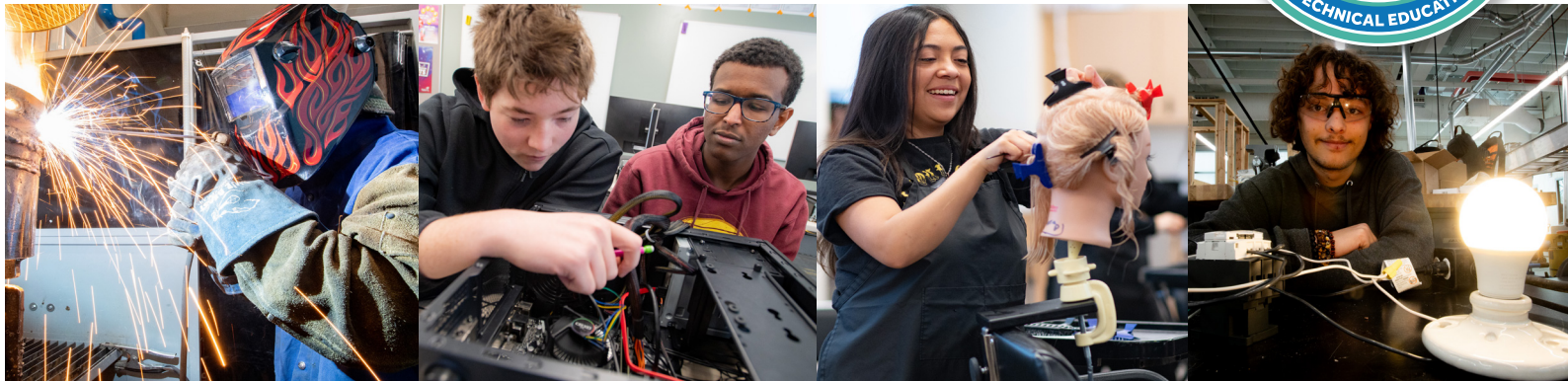




CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION CENTER



D6 PATHWAYS OFFERED AT THE CTE CENTER INCLUDE:



Cosmetology

This pathway is designed to prepare students for a career in Cosmetology by earning 51 college credits and eligible to take the Colorado State board exam.



Construction-Electrical

This pathway is designed to prepare students for a career as an electrician through college courses and hands-on experience within the shop and jobsite.



Teacher Preparation

This pathway is designed to prepare students for a career in education through college courses offered through the University of Northern Colorado. Through these courses students will develop entry-level classroom teaching skills.



Information Technology-Cybersecurity

This pathway is designed to prepare students for a career in cybersecurity through college courses and earning a Network, UNIX and CompTia Certificates.



Welding

This pathway is designed to prepare students for a career in welding through college courses and earning a series of industry certifications.

Application Process:
