HIGH SCHOOL PROFILE 2025-2026

Cole Valley Christian Schools (CVCS) is an Early Childhood Education through 12th grade private, Christian school with just over 1,300 students on two campuses. The Secondary Campus located in Meridian, Idaho, houses grades 6-12. The four-year high school's current enrollment is approximately 425 students. Founded in 1972, the CVCS student body represents over 100 churches from throughout the Treasure Valley.
