

- Funding for 14 Campus Security Liaison
- Funding of 4 additional Middle School Counselors
- Partnership with Restorative Justice League
 - Communication radios for RJL techs
- Purchase of supplies for the Coffee with MCSD Counselor
- Partnership with Playworks
 - Additional hours of pay for Playworks training (5.5 hrs per employee)
- Need: Form CCSPP committee to steer future use of funds-Community Partnership
