1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

The Prop 28 Arts Education Plan aims to enhance arts education access and quality. The plan outlines three main goals: increasing arts education access, enhancing the arts curriculum and instruction, and fostering student engagement. 1. Increase access to arts education by ensuring that every student has access to arts instruction, regardless of their course selection and expanding the arts programs to all students within school. 2. Enhance arts curriculum and instruction by developing a comprehensive arts curriculum that aligns with state standards and encourages creativity, critical thinking and self-expression. Arts lessons will also be integrated into core curriculum aligned with Common Core State Standards and Universal Design for Learning. By providing professional learning opportunities to instructional staff, the instructional materials created by the Visual and Performing Arts department will be utilized by students both synchronously and asynchronously, depending on the needs of the students. 3. Foster student engagement and participation by increasing student participating in arts classes and/or art instructional sessions. This will allow for students to explore various art forms and discover their passions.
