## Exams Information:

- Exam board is AQA.
- Pupils are either taking Separate Sciences in Biology, Chemistry and Physics, OR Combined Science Trilogy.
- All pupils will sit 6 exams in the summer, two for each Science.
- Combined Science exams are 1 hour 15 minutes.
- Separate Science exams are 1 hour 45 minutes.
- There is no coursework for Science.
- Required practicals that you have done throughout the course can appear in questions on the exams.

## Mock Exams:

- In the November mocks, pupils will sit a Paper 1 in each Science.
- In the Spring mocks, pupils will sit a Paper 2 in each Science.

## Past Papers:

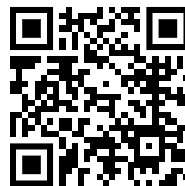
- The MME Revise website is a good source of past papers.

## Educake:

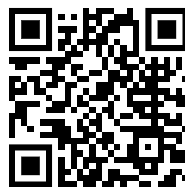
- Make sure you know your username and password. Ask a Science teacher if you need it resetting.
