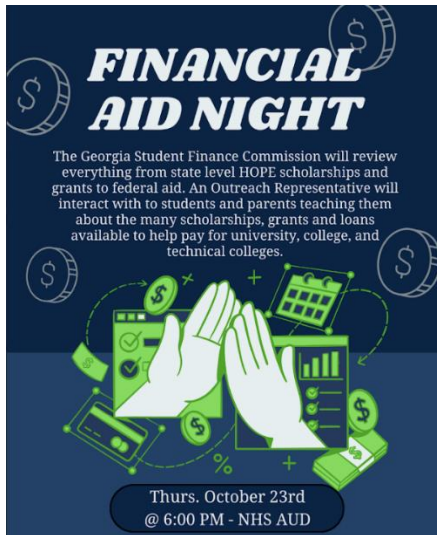
### It's time to register for the Fulton County Technology Competition!

**ASVAB Testing**

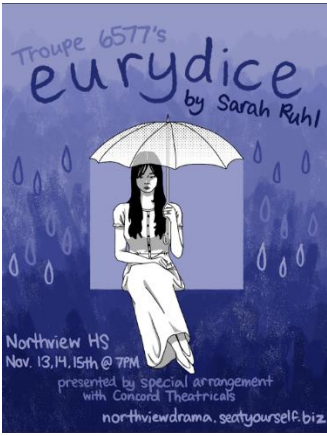
ASVAB testing will be available on Wednesday, November 5 at 8:30 AM.
