THE COMMUNITY: Slidell High School, one of eight public high schools in St. Tammany Parish is located in Slidell, Louisiana, a suburban community approximately thirty miles east of metropolitan New Orleans, LA.

SCHOOL: Slidell High School is a co-ed, public high school enrolling approximately 1600 students in grades 9-12. Approximately, 85% of our graduates continue on to postsecondary education 70% attend four-year colleges universities and 15% to two- year community or technical colleges. There are 367 students in the Senior Class 2026. Slidell High has provided over 100 years of academic excellence.
