PLEASANT VALLEY EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Pleasant Valley Educational Foundation Scholarship Program is intended to promote the teaching profession and provide assistance to a PVHS graduating student who aspires to become an educator. The scholarship recipient will receive \$500 as per the guidelines below.

General Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible for this scholarship the student must be a graduating senior from Pleasant Valley High School, have a GPA of 3.0 or higher and, in the calendar year of graduation, enroll at an accredited two (2) or four (4) year institution in a course of study that, upon completion, will provide them with teacher certification in K-12 schools.

General Information:

The recipient of the scholarship will be awarded a total of \$500. There shall be one (1) recipient per school year.

Scholarship awards are paid directly to the recipient's postsecondary institution in two (2) equal installments. Each installment is contingent upon receipt of the recipient's official transcript (confirming enrollment and attendance) and a letter from a community service advisor or school official (confirming the recipient's participation in a sanctioned community service activity during the fall semester).

Scholarship Application Instructions:

Carefully read and complete the written application. Make sure that you have signed and dated it. The completed application (and all supporting materials) must be received before the deadline. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

PLEASANT VALLEY EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

GUIDELINES

This scholarship will be available for a 2026 graduate of the Pleasant Valley High School. The amount of the scholarship will be a total of five hundred dollars (\$500). There shall be one (1) recipient for 2026.

The recipient must:

- Properly complete and submit an application on or before the stated deadline.
- Be a 2026 graduate of Pleasant Valley High School.
- Display an interest in helping others through performing community service activities that are of an educational nature (as reported on the application).
- Enroll in and attend an accredited two (2) year or four (4) postsecondary institution in a course of study that - upon completion - will provide you with teacher certification in K-12 schools, and become involved in an organization related to K-12 education during the period of attendance.
- Be a full-time student (at least 12 credits per semester) who maintains at least a 3.0 GPA during the period for which the scholarship is awarded.

The recipient will be eligible to receive this scholarship during the first two semesters of enrollment at an accredited post-secondary institution as per the guidelines stated herein. Funds shall be doled out in two (2) payments of \$250. One payment will occur at the completion of the recipient's first semester and only if the recipient maintains a GPA of at least 3.0 as evidenced by their submission to PVEF of a transcript (submitted by February 1, 2027) indicating such. The second installment of funds shall occur at the conclusion of the second semester only if the recipient maintains a GPA of at least 3.0 as evidenced by their submission to PVEF of a transcript (submitted by July 1, 2027) indicating such, as well as proof of participation in community service (a letter from the governing officer of a public service organization[s] confirming participation in community service activities that are of an educational nature).

At all times, in order to be eligible to receive funds, the recipient must be enrolled at the postsecondary institution as a full-time student (at least 12 credit hours) per semester and successfully earn at least 12 credits each semester.

Payments will be made directly by PVEF to the institution upon successfully meeting the above criteria.

As per the stated guidelines, the recipient of this scholarship shall only be eligible once to receive said scholarship.

The recipient of the scholarship shall be chosen by the PVEF Board of Directors upon review of applications and nonpublic discourse by said Directors.
