FSA ID

Attention Seniors : Time to get your FSA ID. An FSA ID is a username and password that students and parents use to log in to Federal Student Aid (.gov) websites, most notably to complete and sign the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form and access information about their federal student aid, such as grants, loans, and work-study. Each person required to provide information on the FAFSA, including students and their parents or spouses, needs their own unique FSA ID, which acts as a legal signature for electronic documents. FAFSA opens Oct. 1st !
