CURRENT BUSINESS (Principal)

1. **SSC Bylaw changes (vote) Mr. Waggle discussed a change in the by laws to allow SSC members to serve longer than 2 years as teachers. He explained that it is difficult to get staff members and those that want to be on should be afforded the ability . adopted 7-0**
2. **Review Safety Plan (First Read) Mr. Waggle talked about the safety plan and that the SSC looks over the electronic copies that were shared. This is a first read and the SSC is encouraged to read and ask questions that come up.**
3. **Discuss Needs Assessments by groups. Mr. Waggle talked about a needs assessment that will be given to stakeholders that will help drive the budget and SPSA. Mr. Waggle asked that the SSC reach out to stakeholder groups and find our issues that should be considered. Mr. Waggle described what**

type of information we are looking for, broader big picture items, not individual complaints.

- 4. Attendance review. Mr. Waggle reminded the group that one of THS' WASC goals is to decrease the amount of chronic absenteeism. Mr. Waggle prepared and shared a document that had THS attendance data over a 5 year period.**

FUTURE BUSINESS (Principal)

- 1. First Quarter Grade review -Mr. Waggle asked for input on what the SSC would like to see, which classes, subjects, or periods. Kids tend to pass classes but do not necessarily match external testing and assessments. Mr. Waggle explain iexcel and the Els are really using it well and really like it. Mr. Waggle asked for ideas of what to see. Mr. Waggle explained the WASC goals on a-g achievement and nothing in particular related to test scores. Ms. Scott asked to see the number of students with multiple Ds or Fs. Mr. Lunetta asked to see grade distribution for math over the years.**
- 2. School Discipline report - Mr. Waggle will bring discipline data. He explained the new Intervention Room in the district used for k-7 and 8-12 to help students not get suspended.**
