## **Course Description/Goals:**

Art I will introduce students to the Principles of Design as well as explore the Elements of Art. Students will be able to use various materials to create original works of art as well as further their knowledge of artist history.

## **Course TEKS/Objectives:**

High school art TEKS objectives are structured under four main strands: Foundations: Observation and Perception, Creative Expression, Historical and Cultural Relevance, and Critical Evaluation and Response. Students are expected to develop visual literacy, create original works using a variety of media, understand art history and culture, and analyze and respond to artworks both their own and others'.

Engaging the artistic exercises, students will be able to communicate their own vision and concepts as well as understanding art processes.
