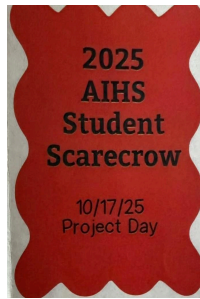
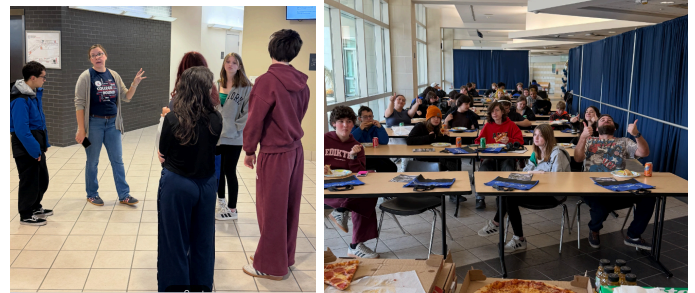




Field Trip to North Shore Community College

Meet Our New Math Teacher Ariana Natoli

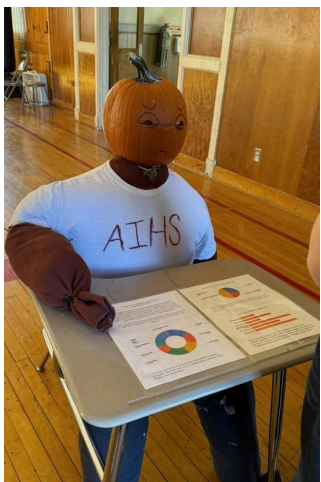


Helping Z and explaining how she has a thing for PostIts.
