Sixth Grade

English Language Arts with Ms. Carter:

In 6th Grade Readers Workshop, we are working on interpreting character and setting in our independent reading books, well as reading Rain is Not My Indian Name, by Cynthia Leitich Smith.

In Writers Workshop. we paragraph practicing writing 5 argument essays, starting with an essay about their favorite dessert.

MN Studies with Ms. Atchison and Mr. Kareem:

Students have been learning about early Dakota history (before the 1800s). Students read value stories to better understand an important value in early Dakota culture. Students learned about jobs in early Dakota history and considered how seasons influenced early Dakota housing and lifestyles.

Seventh Grade

English Language Arts with Ms. Steinhoff:

Ms. Steinhoff's 7th grade students are working on analyzing the identity of different authors' perspectives and how that shapes their writing. Together we have created identity statements (a claim) and we are now working on putting together evidence from the various texts as well as how include strong reasoning to support their statements. Soon, students will be working on a summative assessment where they will use all of their gained knowledge from this unit and show what they know! Lastly, students were given their FAST reading scores as well as their Lexile scores. They then used these to think about how they are (or are not!) challenging themselves with their books. Ask your student what they are reading, and encourage them to read at home as well. "perfect", Practice makes spending extended periods of time engaging in reading at home can support students in making massive gains in their reading skills!

American Studies with Ms. **Newman and Ms. Atchison:**

Seventh grade history is continuing to learn about the US Civil War focusing on the 54th Massachusetts, the Battle of Gettysburg, and the daily life of soldiers and nurses. After the Civil War, we will be learning about Reconstruction and rebuilding after a deadly and destructive fouryear long war.

Personal Finance

Personal Finance with Mr. Gravert:

In personal finance class, we're building essential life skills! We recently wrapped up an insightful unit on consumerism, learning how to be smart shoppers and adopt best practices for spending our money wisely. Now, we're diving into the critical topic of budgeting, where students will learn to create and maintain a spending plan that helps them reach their financial goals. When creating a budget, two great tips are to track every expense for a month before setting categories to see where your money really goes, and to always allocate funds for savings first, treating it like a nonnegotiable bill. This new unit will equip students with the tools they need for a financially stable future.

What Is Schoology?


Schoology is an online Learning Management System that helps you stay informed about your student's classes, assignments and grades. You can use Schoology to:

Navigating Stude nt Schoology Accounts:



Use the left menu to quickly view specific information a bout your student's Schoology Activity:

Summary: Click to see an overview of your student's courses and grades (Enrollments in the center column), or notifications about grades on individual assignments (Student Activity in the middle column).

Grades: Review your student's grades for all courses.

Mastery: If your student's school aligns materials to standards and learning objectives, you can check progress here.

Calendar: Click to view a calendar of past and upcoming events and assignments. Events and assignments in the near future are also listed in the Upcoming column on the right.

Messages: Parents do not have access to Messages.

- Select Enrollments in the center column to see a list of your student's current courses, along with their grade. The grade may not be displayed while the course is in progress, as in the grade column for U.S. History in the sample above. Click on an individual course to see grades for assignments, tests, and discussions.
- Here under **Groups**, you can see a list of your student's Schoology Groups. Groups can be used for a variety of activities, from school projects to extracurricular teams and clubs.
- The Recent Grades/Attendance section displays your student's recent grade. Attendance is not tracked in Schoology. Please refer to the One Stop Campus Portal link to check on attendance.
- The Overdue section displays a list of course materials your student did not turn in by the due date.
