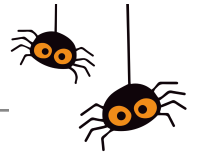

Oct. 31: Student Costume Day @ Creekview Intermediate



Friday, October 31st is Halloween! Again this year we will be allowing our students to dress up on this day. Below you will find information regarding costume expectations.

Student Halloween Costume Expectations

In an effort to enjoy and celebrate Halloween at Creekview Intermediate appropriately, respectfully, and in accordance with school rules, we ask that students use the following guidelines when selecting a costume:

1. No head coverings unless it is part of the costume, NO Halloween masks or FULL face paint. Staff members must be able to identify students.
2. **NO blow up costumes - new this year**
3. Costumes that are provocative, revealing, sexual in nature, or employ questionable props are not permitted.
4. Costumes that depict violence, alcohol, or drugs are not permitted. Fake weapons are not allowed.
5. Costumes that could be offensive or perpetuate a stereotype of someone's culture, gender, heritage, or religion are not permitted.
6. Costumes should not hinder your ability to participate in your classes, including P.E. Costumes may not disrupt or impede traffic, or present issues of safety in the hallway.
7. If you have any questions regarding the appropriateness of your costume idea, we encourage you to speak to your teachers.

Talking points for teachers and parents to assist in this teachable moment

1. Remind students of their audience in the building (students, teachers, parents, community members.)
2. This is a school—what may be appropriate in pop culture or the media may not be appropriate at school
3. We are a community, and we want students to think about how their costume choice may impact others within this community.

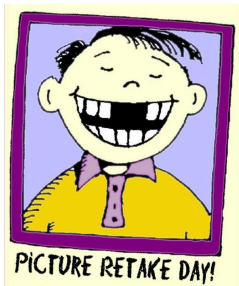

Creekview reports progress on Critical Standards using the scale below. Critical Standards are standards that have been identified as essential to students as they progress through the grade levels. While we report on Critical Standards, it's important to note that each subject area has other State Learning Standards that are also taught and assessed. You will not find these additional standards inside of PowerSchool.

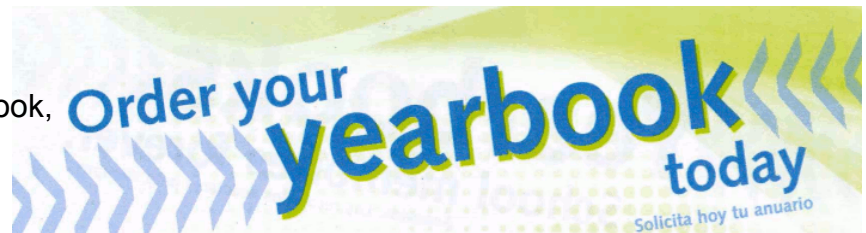
Oct. 20 - Dec. 5: MEVSD Winter Toy Drive
