

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

In order to graduate from North Middlesex Regional High School, a student must have earned at least 120 credits. Course requirements are the following:

English/Language Arts	4 full credit courses
Social Studies	3 full credit courses (Students must pass the civic action project in US History 2)
Mathematics	4 full credit courses
Science	3 full credit lab courses
Physical Education	4 half-credit courses
World Language	2 full credit courses (of the same language)
The Arts	1 half-credit course
Technology	included as an elective

Additionally, a student must meet a competency determination as outlined in Policy IKFA Competency Determination.

Other requirements may be established by the school administration in relation to the particular program; otherwise, the additional credits needed for graduation may be selected from among elective courses. For the total number of credits required, please see the high school program of studies or student handbook.

Credit for Foreign Study: Students who are away for a term or year to participate in a student exchange program or otherwise study abroad may receive credits toward high school graduation when (1) study plans are approved by the school administration in advance; and (2) the institution where the study occurred submits a record of the student's work. In these instances, the Principal and the student's guidance counselor will evaluate the work and assign credit for it according to the standards prevailing in North Middlesex Regional High School.
