In the Classroom (Teachers)

- Provide parents with websites and other resources that strengthen math skills.
- Provide parents with reading and writing resources where parents will learn the writing process that students utilize in school in order to establish common reading and writing techniques and provide techniques for assistance at home.
- Provide parents with code to Canvas to monitor student progress.

At Home (Parents and/or Guardians)

- Make sure my child is using the online platforms for reading a book, at least 30 minutes every day and meeting monthly benchmarks.
- Utilize Canvas and Infinite Campus to monitor my child's progress.
- Make sure my child completes homework daily.
- Make sure my child utilizes the online platforms websites and other resources provided by

- Read a book or text for 30 minutes each night.
- Practice writing an effective five paragraph essay and practice identifying the main parts of an effective essay.
- Practice adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing rational numbers and/or integers for 30 minutes each day

- Complete all homework and classwork assignments.

Communication About Student Learning

- Provide frequent reports to parents on their children's progress through the use of Infinite Campus online grading system and reports sent to student email addresses.
- Provide parent-teacher conference which will be held annually, during which the compact shall be discussed as the compact relates to the individual child's achievement.
- Provide reasonable access to staff opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class and observation of the classroom.
