



PENINSULA ART LEAGUE HIGH SCHOOL ART SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Name of Award: Peninsula Art League Scholarship

Awards: Peninsula Art League awards \$16,000 in scholarships annually to students at Gig Harbor High School, Peninsula High School, The Academies at Henderson Bay, and South Kitsap High School.

Due Date: Scholarship notebooks and art displays are required for all applicants and must be viewed by our committee no later than April 3, 2026.

Minimum Requirements for applicants:

- Pursue an arts education as a primary focus after high school
- Meet the entrance requirements of the arts education program to which they are applying

What the Scholarship Notebook should include:

- Include student grades (2.0 minimum GPA)
- Include evidence of participation in school and community activities
- Students must submit a letter of intent with their scholarship notebook containing future career and educational goals, and art experience. Summarize art experience and career goals in no more than one page, including plans for higher education in the arts field.
- Provide at least one recommendation from an adult, including one from student's art teacher
- Student email (in case we need to contact them)

What the Art Display should include:

- Present original artwork in a professional looking display of student's best work (5 samples minimum, 10 samples maximum). If you have digital or video work, please include that, as well.
- We highly recommend, but do not require, that the students be present to explain their art display and their future plans. This gives the student another chance to stand out from the crowd. We can make arrangements for this to happen during the school day, if that is more convenient.

Eligible Art Study Programs:

Art education, art marketing, art history, ceramics, sculptor, fashion design, fabric design, fine art, food styling, glass, graphic design, digital art, illustration, interior design, photography, pottery, set design

Non-Eligible:

Architecture/drafting, culinary arts (chef/cooking), performing arts (music, dance, acting), choral, woodworking

How the awards are granted:

After the PAL scholarship committee has selected the awards, the recipients will be notified by their high school. Awards will be granted directly to the recipients' post-graduate school of choice upon acceptance and enrollment in that school.
