Halloween Parade Costume Guidelines

To ensure a fun and safe celebration for everyone, please review the following guidelines for our Halloween Parade:

1. Costumes should be worn over **regular clothing or spirit wear**.
2. **Appropriate shoes** for school must be worn at all times.
3. **Masks and full-face paint are not permitted** for students or visitors.
4. Costumes should be **age-appropriate** and suitable for the school environment.
5. Costumes must **not be scary, gory, or inappropriate** for school.
6. **Dangerous props** such as swords, weapons, or unsafe objects are **not allowed**.
7. Students who prefer **not to participate** in the Halloween Parade may stay in the office. Please notify your child's teacher in advance.

If a student arrives in an inappropriate costume, parents may be contacted to bring appropriate school clothing.
