- **Tuesday, December 9, 2025** - Time: 12:15 p.m. – 7:15 p.m.

You **must schedule an appointment** to meet with a representative. Each appointment will take approximately 15 minutes.

How to Schedule Your Appointment:

1. Go to www.cefndn.org
2. Click on “Schedule Your CEF Appointment” click **NEXT**
3. Search and select **Cathedral High School** as your location, click “**Next**”
4. Choose a date and time (Nov 6 or Dec 9 between 12:15 and 7:15pm) click “**Next**”
5. Enter your information. Be sure to include your **cell phone number and email** to receive a reminder
Click “**Save**” and print/save your confirmation page.

What to Bring to Your Appointment:

Please complete the enclosed application and bring it along with the **required proof of income**:

1. **If you file taxes:**
 - **2024 Federal Income Tax Return (1040, 1040A, or 1040EZ)**
 - **2024 W-2s**
 - All supporting schedules for self-employment or business income
 - If parents/guardians file separately, tax returns from both are required
 - The student must be listed as a dependent
2. **If you do not file taxes:**
 - Documentation for all sources of **non-taxable income**, such as:
Social Security, TANF, Child Support, CalFresh, Workers' Compensation, Alimony, Section 8, or Public Housing
3. **If you receive cash income only:**
 - **A Notarized Statement of Income** (enclosed form)
 - The statement must be signed and sealed by a notary public
