SUBJECT: Impact Aid Parent - Pupil Survey

- 1. Impact Aid is a Federal education program that reimburses school districts for the lost revenue and additional costs associated with the presence of non-taxable Federal property, including military installations. It is crucial that you respond to the Parent Pupil survey which your public school will distribute during the next few weeks to maximize the allocation of Federal Impact Aid dollars to your district. Impact Aid dollars may be used for instructional materials, teacher salaries, transportation, technology, social emotional support or facilities.
- 2. Soldiers, Civilians and contractors all contribute to how much their public school district qualifies for Federal Impact Aid. Your response to the Parent Pupil survey will make a difference to the amount of Impact aid dollars your school district receives.
