Individual Materials: Each child will need the following:

At Kinawa Montessori, we spend a lot of time helping students learn executive functioning skills, and being organized for class. Color coordinating materials (folders and notebooks) makes it easier for us to develop lessons for these skills. We understand, colors don't match/work out, but when feasible, these colors are utilized in the classroom. Our class work generally follows this color scheme: Red is for Math, Blue - science, Green - Humanities, Yellow - Writing/Reading)

- Eight Spiral Notebooks (2 of each: red, yellow, green, blue...we will use 1 of each color in the fall through winter and 1 of each from winter through spring)
- 4 Durable 2-pocket folder - (preferred one of each color: blue, green, red, yellow).
- 2 marbled composition books
- Pencils (Ticonderoga brand recommended)
- Hand-held pencil sharpener (with top/covering)
- Pencil case/box
- One pair of scissors
- Gluesticks
- Headphones (Wired–NOT Bluetooth)
- Dry erase markers (black)
- Sticky notes (multi-color)
- Colored pencils (hand-held sharpener recommended)
- Tape
- Reusable Water Bottle-with name clearly written on

6th grade ONLY:

- 1 inch binder (the one with clear plastic on the outside is helpful for labeling)

Community Materials:

- Extra pencils (Ticonderoga brand)
- Tissues (the softer the better!)
- Note cards
- Sharpies (black)
- Thin tip markers
