6B	<p>Expects fair and equitable treatment of all staff and students</p> <p>Maintains a calm and controlled demeanor when dealing with difficult students, parents and situations</p> <p>Shows professional demeanor in front of students</p> <p>Maintains appropriate boundaries with students</p> <p>Allows all student voices to be heard when given respectfully and does not belittle students when opinions differ from their own</p> <p>Shows respect for the opinions of specialists (SPED, Speech Language Pathologist, Psychologists, Behavioral Specialist, etc...)</p> <p>Adheres to confidentiality practices and policies, sharing with only those that need to know to educate and care for a student</p>

6C	<p>Uses respectful language and tone when talking to students, parents and staff members</p> <p>Uses appropriate language (no swearing/demeaning language) while on school property, or at school sanctioned events</p> <p>Communicates frequently regarding student's positive accomplishments as well as challenges and needs</p> <p>Uses appropriate channels for communicating with students and parents.</p> <p>Notifies parents of academic concerns as soon as they arise.</p> <p>Expresses concerns in a positive and productive manner (not using a condescending tone or casting blame)</p> <p>Praise in public and correct in private</p>

6D	<p>Follows initiative requirements and when needing to question, does so in a respectful manner</p> <p>Works to support others with implementation of building/district initiative and avoids intentional undermining of building/district initiatives</p> <p>Shares student data when required for another educator to complete their job.</p> <p>Works to support others with implementation of building/district initiative and avoids intentional undermining of building/district initiatives</p> <p>Shares with specialists regarding student's class performance in order to enhance the IEP process</p> <p>Maintains accurate attendance records per building policy</p> <p>Maintains an accurate grade book per building policy</p> <p>Arrives to work on time, prepared to carry out educational responsibilities</p> <p>Responds to emails in a timely manner</p> <p>Completes Report Cards/Progress Reports on time.</p>
