

LOCATION

Briercrest College is situated just off the Trans-Canada Highway in the village of Caronport, Saskatchewan, approximately 15 minutes west of Moose Jaw and one hour west of Regina. This prime location combines the convenience of nearby city amenities with the charm and tranquillity of small-town life.

Our campus features six college dormitories, an academic building, a gymnasium, an ice rink, a cafeteria, and a high-performance training center.




A REDESIGNED CHRISTIAN MINISTRY PROGRAM

Our refreshed Christian Ministry program combines biblical and practical training to prepare students for a life of mission and servant leadership in the church.

This four year program now includes a **one-year internship**.



SACRED MUSIC

This direct-entry program is an excellent choice for students who excel in the performing arts and wish to develop their talents in a Christian environment. Students grow by studying the bible, theology, Christian ministry, and the arts and sciences, all while receiving high-level classical training. This comprehensive approach helps students become skilled and confident musicians.



WORSHIP ARTS

This concentration is a great option for students who want to use their musical gifts to serve the Church, or who want to gain a broader understanding of Christian worship.

The 120-credit hour BA Applied Linguistics: TESOL degree provides the highest level of English language teacher training from a nationally recognized and provincially-authorized undergraduate program.

5 Year BA + MA Biblical Studies Pathway

The 5 Year BA + MA Pathway enables students to graduate with both a Bachelor of Arts and a Master of Arts in just five years!

COMMUNICATION DISORDERS (BA/BS WITH MINOT STATE UNIVERSITY)

Study in a partnership degree that sets you apart. Begin at Briercrest, where you'll gain a spiritual and academic foundation, before transferring to Minot State to specialize in your field. Graduate with a BA in Psychology from Briercrest and a BS in Communications Disorders from MSU.



ADMISSIONS

1. COMPLETE THE ONLINE APPLICATION

Submit your application at briercrestcollege.ca/admissions

2. SUBMIT A NON-REFUNDABLE APPLICATION FEE

Your application is reviewed after the application fee is received. The cost is \$100 for Canadian students and \$150 for international students.

3. SUBMIT TRANSCRIPTS

Current high school students: submit up to date transcript including grade 11 marks and a list of grade 12 courses.

High school graduates: submit final high school transcript.

Home School student/graduate: visit our website for instructions on submitting official documents.

Transfer students: submit high school and post secondary transcripts from any previous studies.

**Official transcripts are required before starting classes and are sent directly from your provincial Ministry of Education.*
