Parent and Family Engagement Policy

The Parent and Family Engagement Policy was developed in collaboration with parents. Parents, community members, and school staff will update and review the policy annually. - Eligibility Parents' right-to-know requirements.
- Opportunities -Events, Trainings, Workshops, and Meetings for parents will be held monthly or in conjunction with existing school events held in the AM and PM to accommodate family schedules. Scheduled meetings include Annual Title I Meetings, Family Literacy Night, Open House, and Curriculum Night. Refreshments may be provided to help increase parents' attendance at meetings.
