- From Nurse Hames:
 - o Routine head lice checks recommended:
 - Head lice are a common problem among elementary children so weekly hair checks should become a regular routine with hair hygiene. Head lice can crawl from head to head when children play or work closely together. It is much easier to get rid of a head lice infestation if it is caught early. In addition to routine checks, it is a good idea to check your child's head before and after attending a sleepover. Head lice can be a nuisance but they have not been shown to spread disease. 
