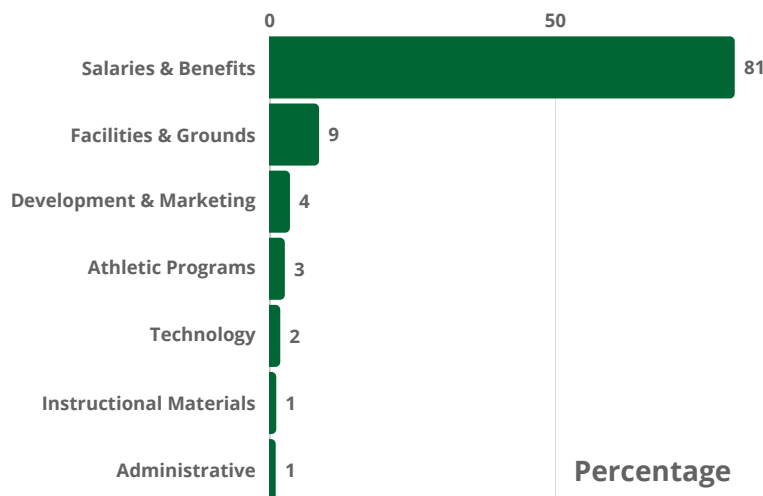

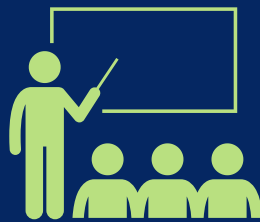

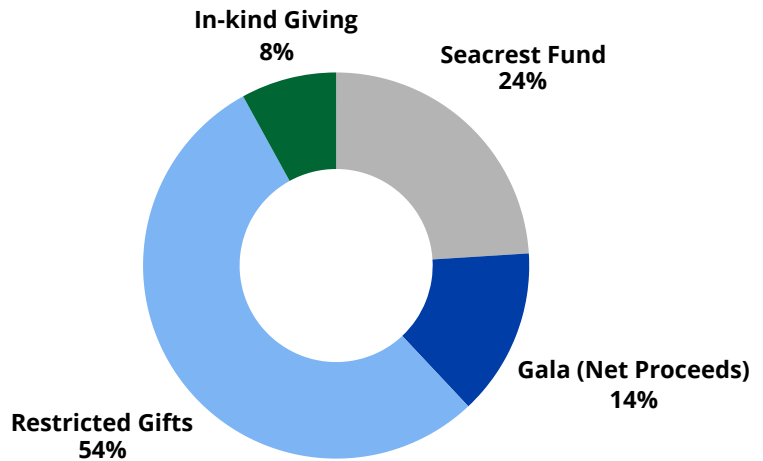

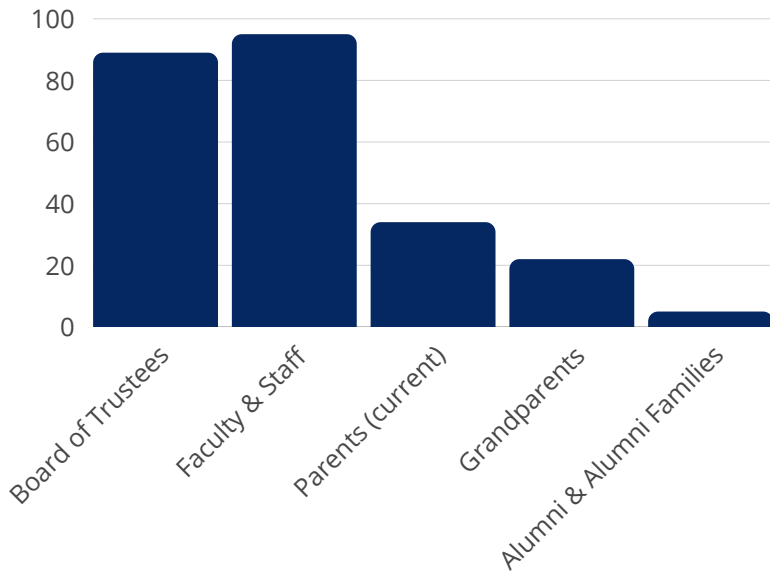
Seacrest Country Day School celebrates the generosity of each of our donors who supports our students with a philanthropic gift during the school year. We are grateful to our donors for their contribution!

Scholarships & Awards



Erickson-Hastings Award

In 2017, Dr. John and Bonnie Watson established two awards to be given annually in honor of former Board of Trustees Co-Chairs, Trish Erickson and Carol Hastings. Mrs. Erickson and Mrs. Hastings were the first Co-Chairs of the Board to partner in support of the Seacrest community. The awards are given to two teachers who have inspired the Seacrest community by providing a collaborative opportunity for their students that enhances our School's mission.

The Erickson-Hastings Award for 2024-25 goes to **Kory Gallagher, Tyra Turner and Jennifer Theel** for their work to collaborate and align with the three divisions to make a more cohesive pre-school - grade 12 program.

Jeffrey Ortiz '12 Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded each year to a graduating senior who has been:

- a committed athlete for his or her entire upper school career
- a positive and actively involved member of the school community
- a student who consistently exhibited a spirit of joy and compassion

The Head of School Award

Established in 2023 by an anonymous donor, this award is the highest honor given to the member of the graduating class. A student with outstanding leadership and strength of character, the recipient of this award has earned the highest respect of both peers and teachers for the generous contributions of his/her time, talent, and energy to the Seacrest ideals of dignity, integrity, humility, service, and sincerity.

The Head of School Award recipient for 2024-25 is **Charlotte Cook '25**. Charlotte will be studying at Florida Gulf Coast University in the fall.

- Class of 2025
 - 32 graduating students
 - Three graduating seniors are "Seacrest Lifers" (been a Seacrest student since Kindergarten)
 - The class of 2025 completed 6,082 community service hours (190 per student) including peer mentoring and other Seacrest volunteer opportunities, animal shelter service, work at the Conservancy next to the zoo, and swim coaching to name a few.
 - 29 out of 32 students (91%) participated in the college application process, and between them gained 316 acceptances to 96 universities and colleges in 31 states and the District of Columbia. 2 entered the workforce directly and 1 chose to attend trade school.
 - Of those 29, 14 (48%) chose to attend public or private colleges in FL, and 15 (52%) chose to attend school out of state.
 - \$15,100,000 in total scholarships awarded across all acceptances.
 - 28 of 29 received merit scholarships (97%)
 - 8 of 29 (28%) received athletic aid and were recruited athletes.

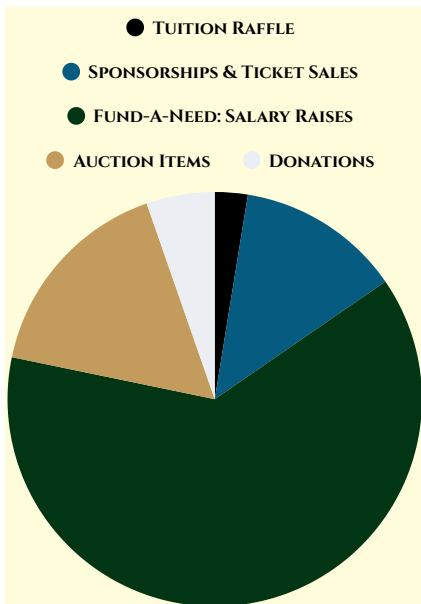

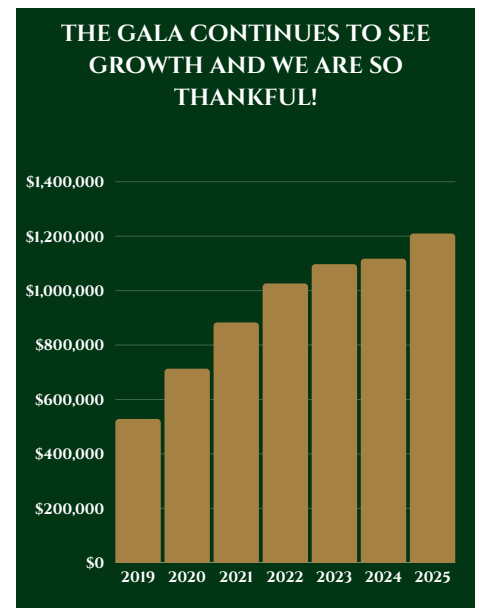
