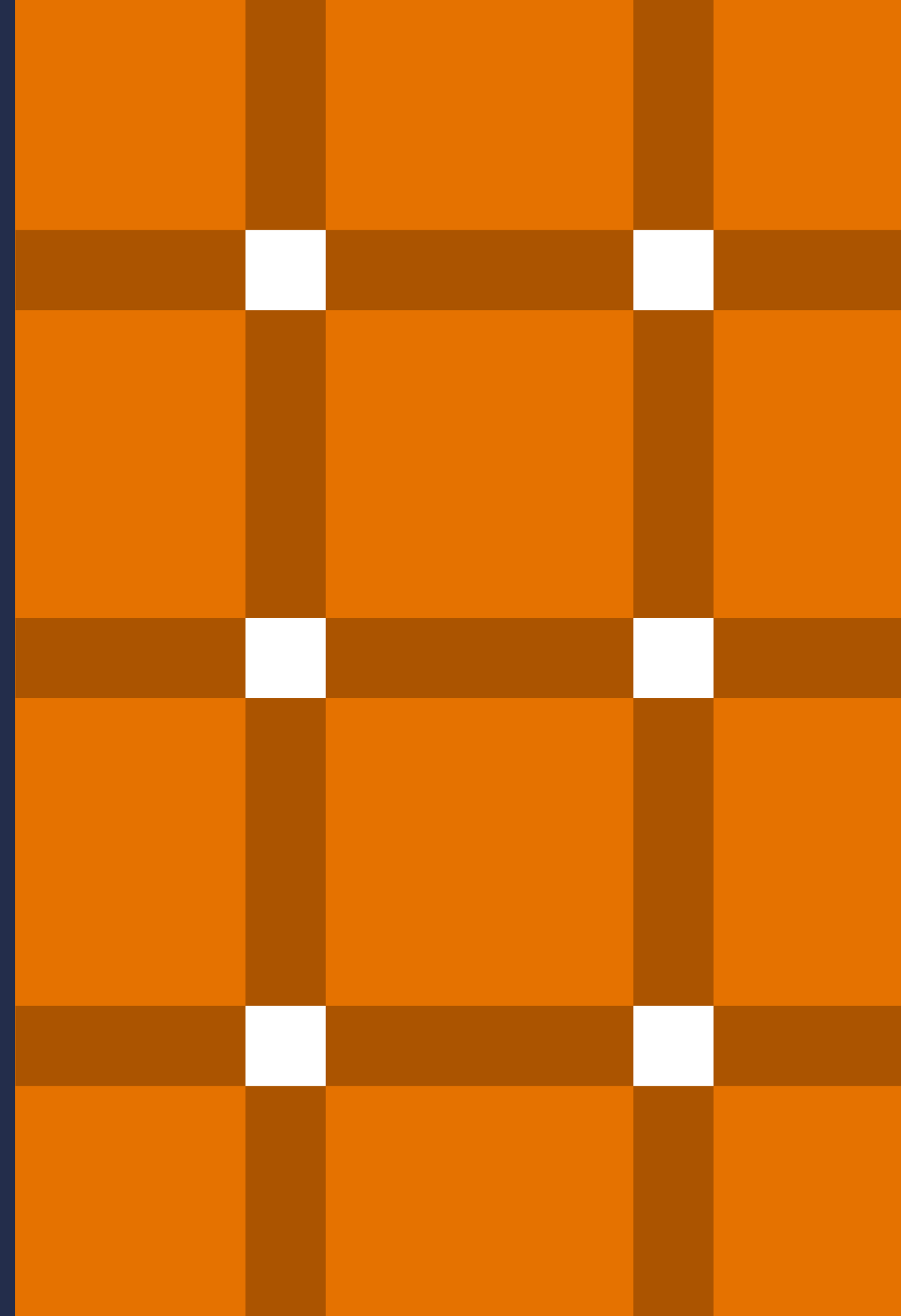


# Governance

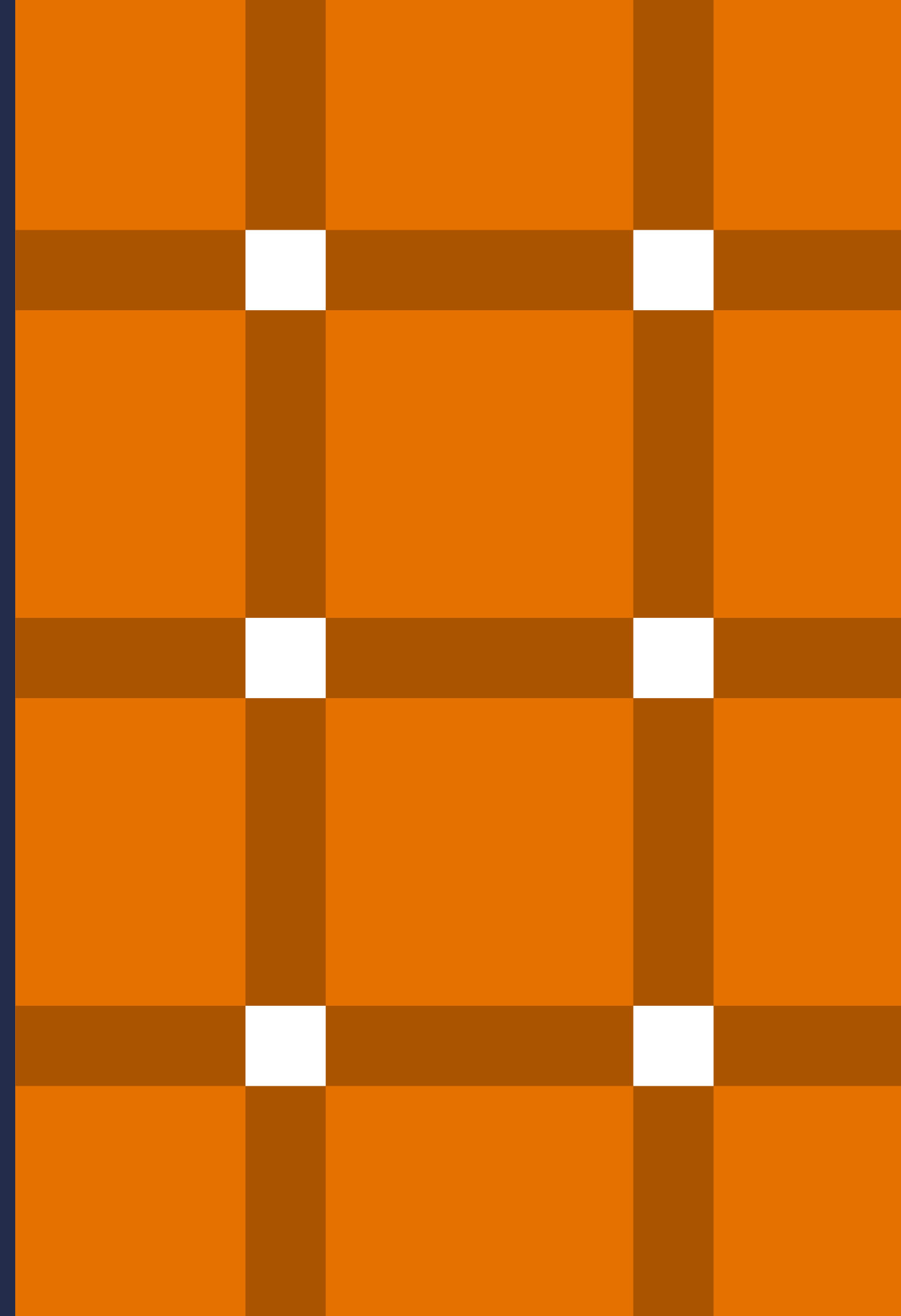
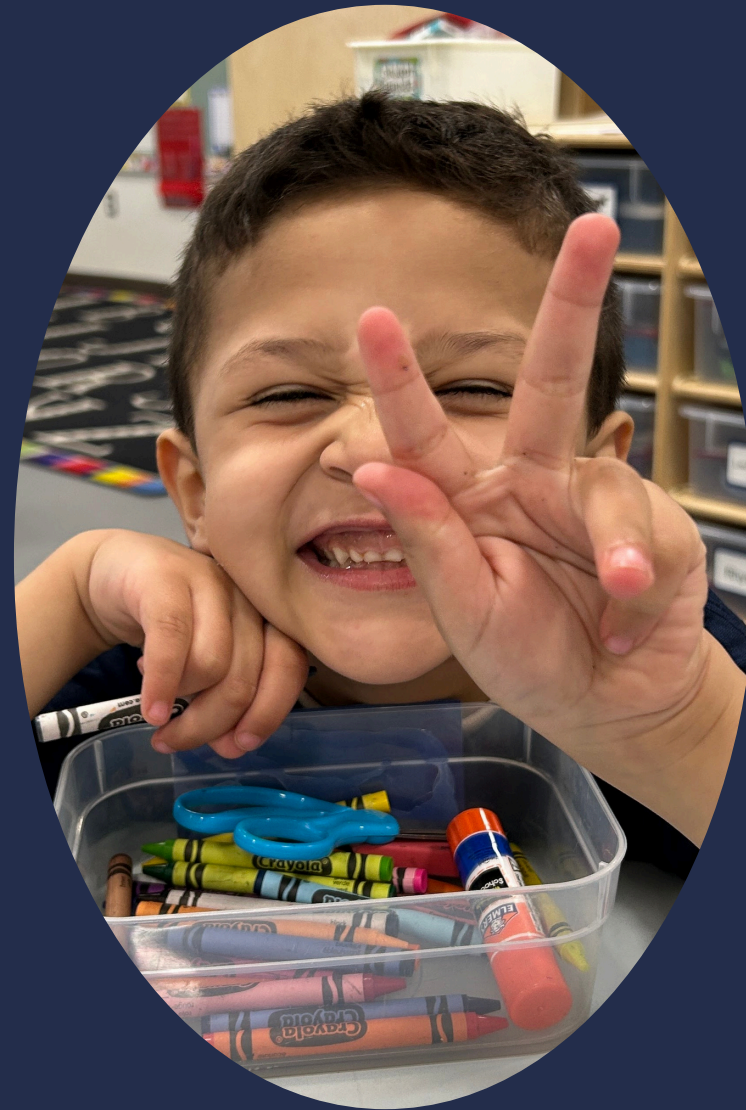
All public schools, private schools for special education, and public regional centers/programs must report SBAR data.



# Events Reported

Discipline events are reported that occur:

- During the school day
- During a school-sponsored activity
- Not during school or activities
- In transit on the way to school or from school

## School Level Sanctions

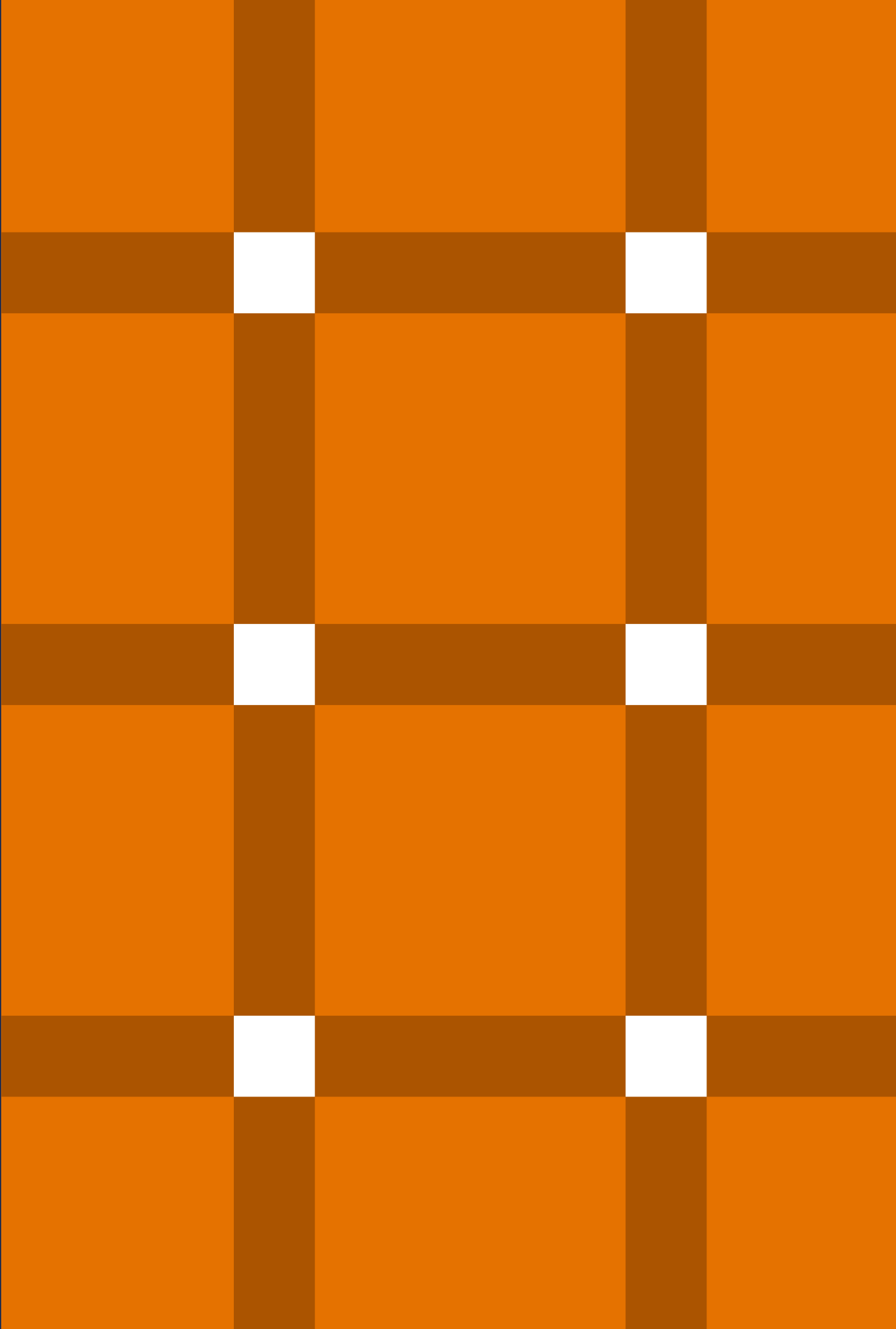
- Class Removal
