The ASD community will vote on two propositions November 4.

Proposition 1 will build the district's fifth middle school on district property on Sumner-Tapps Highway E, build a new Cascade Middle School on ASD property on I St NE and 40th St NE and build a new Alpac Elementary School its current site. Cascade is 58 years old and Alpac is 53 years old.

More than 900 middle school students currently attend classes in 43 portables across the four middle schools. The average cost if the bond is approved is \$1.04 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation and the total bond package will not exceed \$490 million.

Proposition 2 is a Safety, Security, Facility Improvements & Technology Replacement Levy. If passed, the 6-year levy will improve safety and security, make facility improvements in teaching and learning environments at 16 schools and support buildings and replace the expiring technology levy. The facility improvement are budgeted at \$53.4 million and the expiring technology levy is \$57.4 million.

If both propositions pass, the estimated increase is \$1.29 per/\$1,000 of assessed valuation due to paying off other debt and the proposed construction schedule.

Who at school has your back?



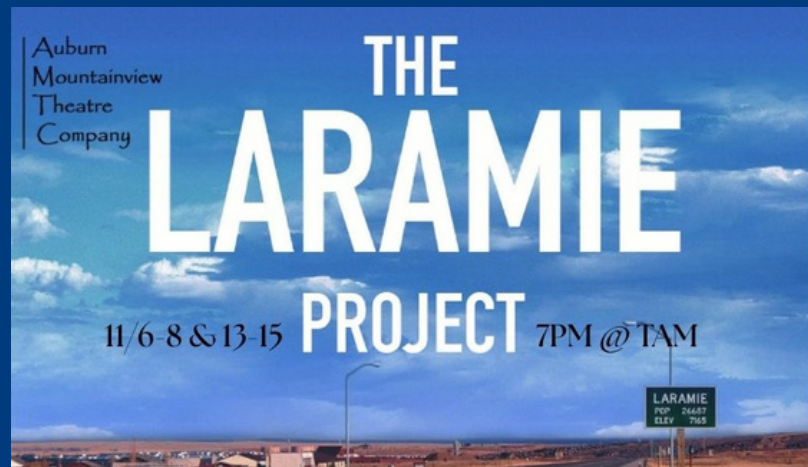
Why are you letting other people get to you?
