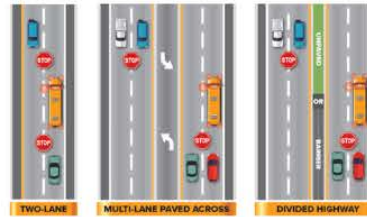


DID YOU KNOW?

The New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law States...

It is illegal to pass a stopped school bus when the red lights are active, and the stop arm is extended. Drivers must always stop for flashing red lights, even on divided highways and school grounds. Drivers must stop whether approaching the school bus from the front or from the rear. Municipalities in New York are authorized to install stop-arm cameras on school buses that ticket drivers who pass stopped school buses. The fine for a first-time violation of illegally passing a stopped school bus is \$250 and may reach up to \$1,500 and/or up to 180 days in jail for repeat violations.

Safety precautions for our scholars:

- **Stay Seated, Stay Safe:** Always stay seated while the bus is moving to avoid injuries.
- **Be Alert, Be Seen:** Make sure the bus driver can see you when boarding or exiting the bus.
- **Listen to Your Driver:** Follow the bus driver's instructions for a safe ride.
- **No Distracting the Driver:** Avoid loud noises and disruptive behavior to help the driver focus.
- **Wait for the Signal:** Cross the street only when the driver signals it's safe.
- **Stop, Look, and Listen:** Always check for traffic before crossing the street.
- **Respect Your Fellow Passengers:** Treat others kindly and keep the bus a safe place for everyone.

The Westbury Union Free School District Board of Education will provide transportation to public and non-public school students who reside within designated distances from the school they attend in accordance with the applicable section of the Education Law and rulings of the Commissioner of Education.

Transportation will be provided to the school students attend as follows:

- **For pupils in Kindergarten, who live zero miles or more**
- **For pupils in Grades 1-5, who live at least one half of a mile or more**
- **For pupils in Grades 6-12, who live at least one mile or more**

Students must meet these requirements to be approved for district transportation. Distances from all homes in the district to all schools serving those homes have been calculated. It is the distances that determine eligibility. School bus transportation is provided to students that meet the mileage requirements. The Transportation Department or a designee shall determine bus stops and shall designate the specific bus to be taken by the student to and from school, and the pupil shall have no authority to ride any other bus. Buses will stop for pick-up and drop-off of passengers based on area. All students in the area shall walk to the spot designated on their Bus Pass.

Should you wish the Transportation Department to review a student's bus stop assignment; please complete the BUS STOP REVIEW FORM available in English, Spanish and Haitian-Creole.

Where a request for transportation is based on a medical condition, consideration is based on the nature and severity of the medical concern. Parents seeking a medical bus pass should apply to the school nurse at the school which the student attends. Students with unique learning situations should contact the Pupil Personnel Office at 516-876-5119 to discuss any special transportation requirements.

Non-Public School Transportation Request

To apply for parochial/private school transportation. Please Note: Requests must be submitted by April 1st of the prior year or within 30 days of establishing residency.



Bus Stop Review Form

To request a change on a child's assigned bus pass due to safety concerns.



Child Care Transportation Request

To request a change on a child's pick up/drop location other than their home address.

(For Pre-K to 8th Grade students)



If you move, you must notify the Central Registration Office to complete an Address Change Form prior to requesting a new bus pass.
