Members of Anime Club are all smiles while hanging out! Anime Club meets on Fridays with Ms. Amans.




CLUB ATTENDANCE

Bottom Right Picture: Students in Eco Club are teaching our families about Recycling at Franklin. Eco Club meets Fridays with Mrs. Lisha.




