



Medical Treatment Locations for Employees Injured at Work

CCSD 15 has established agreements with both Northwest Community Healthcare and AMITA Health to provide medical treatment for CCSD 15 employees who are injured at work.

The purpose of these agreements is to make available local medical services that provide preferred treatment with minimal paperwork involved for the employee. This will allow district employees to receive high quality medical treatment and return to work as quickly as possible. District employees are encouraged, but not required, to visit these treatment centers for work-related injuries. Employees always have the option of visiting their own doctor for medical treatment.
