Scholarship History:

This scholarship was established in 2020.

Eligibility: This up to \$500 scholarship will be granted to one graduating senior from West High School at the awards program each May. The award will go to the most deserving student as judged by the Industrial Technical Department at West High School. The amount may vary depending on the fund's investment performance in any given year.

Requirements: Applicants must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5, and file a FAFSA report with their application. In addition, a letter of recommendation from their technology instructor is required.

Award: The recipient will be announced at the winner's school at their awards program in May. The amount of the award may vary according to available funding, with an expected minimum award of \$500. The scholarship is a non-renewing scholarship – available for one year only.

Selection Committee: Applications will be reviewed and the winner selected by the West High School Industrial Technology Department.

If awarded this scholarship a verification of enrollment (Student Information Form) must be submitted to the Davenport Schools Foundation office by **June 1**. Failure to submit the Student Information Form may forfeit an award. Award funds will be distributed to the institution of enrollment in August.
