ESL and SPED classes are not included, as they are not scheduled consistently.  
 Elementary (K-5) Specialists classes are not scheduled consistently and are not included (PE, Art, Dance).  
 Teaching assistant and Study halls are not included.  
 Blended grade classes are included in the median for the lowest grade (ex. if a school has a 3/4 blend, all the students would be included in the average and median for 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> grade).  
 Classes with multiple teachers are only included once.  
 Starting in 2019-20, PK students are excluded from all class size calculations. This makes the data more comparable across schools. Caution should be used in comparing prior year reports though.
