Voted on SHAC Co-Chair. Jessica Peoples was unanimously elected for the 2025-2026 school year.

Kail Winfrey gave a Cenikor presentation. Cenikor is a Non-profit, 3rd organization partnering with Willis ISD to address our students' social-emotional needs and skills.

- Cenikor's initiative is to provide prevention education that empowers youth and families through health and wellness.
- This will help our community learn to make healthier choices, understand the impact of their actions, and develop stronger coping and resilience skills.
- WISD has a memorandum of understanding with Cenikor to implement two of their programs, including Positive Action, a K-12 curriculum that takes a whole-student approach.
- This is an age-appropriate, evidence-based curriculum.
- Prevention specialists will provide presentations at schools, parent groups, and other community groups.
- Students will be taught the skills necessary to develop good self-esteem, bullying prevention, conflict resolution, communication, resisting peer and media pressure, and ways to avoid substance abuse through tobacco, alcohol, and drug-free activities.
