In addition, the District continues to provide quidance and ancillary service programming to complement and supplement special education services. Special education services are available to all special needs students enrolled in the Stafford Schools. When need is determined, children in special education programs receive the benefit of specially trained teachers, child study teams, speech therapists, occupational therapists, and physical therapists.
