GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR BIDDERS

Bidders and successful bidders will be bound to the conditions and requirements set forth in these general instructions, and such instruction shall form an integral part of each purchase contract awarded by the School District.

BIDS

1. All bids must be submitted on and in accordance with instructions provided by the Board.
2. All bids received after the time stated in the Notice to Bidders may not be considered and will be returned unopened to the bidder. The bidder assumes the risk of any delay in the mail or in the handling of the mail by employees of the school district. Whether sent by mail or by means of personal delivery, the bidder assumes responsibility for having his bid deposited on time at the place specified.
3. The submission of a bid will be construed to mean that the bidder is fully informed as to the extent and character of the supplies, materials, or equipment required and a representation that the bidder can furnish the supplies, materials, or equipment satisfactorily in complete compliance with the specifications.
4. Sales to school districts are not affected by any fair-trade agreements. (General Business Law, Sec. 339-a. Sub. 3)
5. No charge will be allowed for federal, state, or municipal sales and excise taxes since the school district is exempt from such taxes. The price bid shall be net and shall not include the amount of any such tax.
6. In all specifications, the words "or equal" are understood after each article giving manufacturer's name or catalog reference, or on any patented article. The decision of the school district as to whether an alternate or substitution is in fact "equal" shall be final. If bidding on items other than those specified, bidder must in every instance give the trade designation of the article, manufacturer's name, and detailed specification of item he proposes to furnish. Otherwise, bid will be construed as submitted on the identical item as specified.
7. When bids are requested on a lump sum basis, bidder must bid on each item in the lump sum group.
8. All prices quoted must be "per unit" as specified.
9. Bidder must insert the price per unit and the extensions against each item in his bid. In the event of a discrepancy between the unit price and the extension, the unit price will govern. Prices shall be extended in decimals, not fractions.

10. Prices shall be net, including transportation and delivery charges fully prepaid by the successful bidder to destination indicated in the proposal. If award is made on any other basis, transportation charges must be prepaid by the successful bidder and added to the invoice as a separate item. In any case, title shall not pass until items have been delivered and accepted.
11. All bids must be sealed and submitted in plain, opaque envelopes. Bid envelopes must be clearly marked "BID". Also, the date and time of the bid opening as indicated on the Notice to Bidders should appear on the envelope.
12. If the supplies, materials, or equipment are to be delivered over an extended period of time, or if the specification so state, then the successful bidder may be required to execute an agreement in relation to the performance of his contract. If the specifications so state, the successful bidder also may be required to furnish a performance bond equal to the full amount of the contract to guarantee the faithful performance of such contract.

SAMPLES

1. The school district reserves the right to request a representative sample of the item quoted upon either prior to the award or before shipments are made.
2. Samples, when required, must be submitted strictly in accordance with instructions.

AWARD

1. Award will be made to the lowest responsible bidder, as will best promote the public interest taking into consideration the reliability of the bidder, the quality of the materials, equipment, or supplies to be furnished, their conformity with the specifications, the purposes for which required, and the terms of delivery.
2. The school district reserves the right to reject all bids. Also, reserved is the right to reject, for cause, any bid in whole or in part; to waive technical defects; qualifications; irregularities; and omissions if in its judgment the best interests of the district will be served.
3. Where a bidder is requested to submit a bid on individual items and also on a total sum or sums, the right is reserved to award contracts on individual items or on total sums.
4. If two or more bidders submit identical bids as to price, the decision of the Board to award a contract to one of such identical bidders shall be final.
5. A contract may be cancelled for non-performance.

GUARANTEES BY THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER

The successful bidder guarantees: (a) his products against defective material or workmanship and to repair or replace any damages or marring occasioned in transit; (b) that all deliveries will be equal to the accepted bid sample; (c) that the equipment or furniture delivered is standard, new, latest model of regular stock product as required by the specifications. Any merchandise provided under the contract, which is or becomes defective during the guarantee period, shall be replaced by the successful bidder free of charge with the specific understanding that all replacements shall carry the same guarantee as the original equipment. The successful bidder shall make any such replacement immediately upon receiving notice from the school district.

DELIVERY

The successful bidder shall be responsible for delivery of items in good condition at point of destination. He shall file with the carrier all claims for breakage, imperfections, and other losses, which will be deducted from invoices. The receiving school district will note for the benefit of the successful bidder when packages are not received in good condition.

SAVING CLAUSE

The successful bidder shall not be responsible for any delays caused by wars, acts of public enemies, strikes, fires, floods, acts of God, or for any other acts not within the control of the successful bidder, and which, by the exercise of reasonable diligence he is unable to prevent.

NON-COLLUSIVE BIDDING CERTIFICATION REQUIRED BY SECTION 139-D OF THE STATE FINANCE LAW

SECTION 139-D, Statement of Non-Collusion in bids to the State:

BY SUBMISSION OF THIS BID, BIDDER AND EACH PERSON SIGNING ON BEHALF OF BIDDER CERTIFIES, AND IN THE CASE OF JOINT BID, EACH PARTY THERETO CERTIFIES AS TO ITS OWN ORGANIZATION, UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY, THAT TO THE BEST OF HIS/HER KNOWLEDGE AND BELIEF:

[1] The prices of this bid have been arrived at independently, without collusion, consultation, communication, or agreement, for the purposes of restricting competition, as to any matter relating to such prices with any other Bidder or with any competitor;

[2] Unless otherwise required by law, the prices which have been quoted in this bid have not been knowingly disclosed by the Bidder and will not knowingly be disclosed by the Bidder prior to opening, directly or indirectly, to any other Bidder or to any competitor; and

[3] No attempt has been made or will be made by the Bidder to induce any other person, partnership or corporation to submit or not to submit a bid for the purpose of restricting competition.

A BID SHALL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR AWARD NOR SHALL ANY AWARD BE MADE WHERE [1], [2], [3] ABOVE HAVE NOT BEEN COMPLIED WITH; PROVIDED HOWEVER, THAT IF IN ANY CASE THE BIDDER(S) CANNOT MAKE THE FOREGOING CERTIFICATION, THE BIDDER SHALL SO STATE AND SHALL FURNISH BELOW A SIGNED STATEMENT WHICH SETS FORTH IN DETAIL THE REASONS THEREFORE:
