4. Norse	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Nordic and Viking civilization and culture, overarching mythos, Norse pantheon, gods as a projection of humanity, Ragnarok	3 weeks
5. Indigenous peoples	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Indigenous civilization and culture, lack of overarching mythos or detailed pantheon, totems and totem poles, anthropomorphic animals, oral tradition	3 weeks
6. Egyptian	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Egyptian civilization and culture, overarching mythos, Egyptian pantheon, geographical factors, longevity	3 weeks
