




Monday Morning Fun - Every Monday, 10am - 12pm

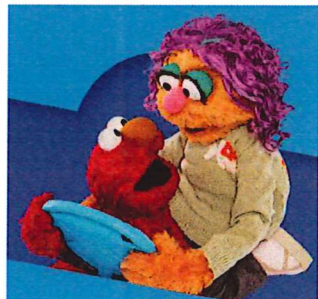
Make new friends while playing with some fun toys!
