



A Public High School Creating Alabama Healthcare Heroes

A free, state-funded residential high school opening in Fall 2026, giving motivated students from across Alabama the chance to live, learn, and prepare for meaningful healthcare careers.

The Alabama School of Healthcare Sciences (ASHS) is the state's first residential high school dedicated entirely to healthcare education. ASHS will combine rigorous academics, hands-on healthcare experience, and real-world workforce preparation. Students earn college credits, gain healthcare certifications, and graduate ready to enter the healthcare workforce or continue their studies with a head start on a college degree.

WHAT STUDENTS WILL LEARN

A Powerful Blend of Academics and Real-World Training

ASHS students complete a challenging academic curriculum built around science, technology, and healthcare innovation. Courses are aligned with Alabama's education standards and enhanced through partnerships with healthcare providers and colleges.

Students explore three major areas of study:

- **Nursing:** Hands-on clinical learning that leads directly to in-demand healthcare careers.
- **Biomedical Sciences/Pre-med:** Advanced coursework and dual enrollment for students planning to pursue medicine or research.
- **Allied Health:** Options such as pharmacy, respiratory therapy, and radiology technology — essential roles in every healthcare setting.
