In addition, room, Board, Transportation and Miscellaneous Expenses are not included in the totals above.

2. As a reminder, the FAFSA Simplification Act changed the process for determining the amount of a student’s Scheduled Pell Grant award. The Department will no longer publish a Pell Grant Payment and Disbursement Schedule for use in determining a student’s Pell Grant Scheduled Award for the award year. Instead, each student’s Scheduled Award is one of the following:

- A Maximum Pell Grant Award is \$7,395
- Student Aid Index (SAI) – calculated Pell Grant, determined by subtracting the student’s SAI from the annual published maximum Pell Grant amount.
 - For example: \$7,395 – 2230 (SAI) = \$5,165 (estimated Pell Grant Award)
- A minimum Pell Grant Award is \$740

If the amount of Pell Grant and Direct Loans is less than the cost, you will need to pay the school the balance according to the school's payment schedule.

If the amount of Grants and Direct Loans are greater than the cost, you will have a credit balance. Credit balances occur when federal funds have been received by the school and your tuition and approved costs have been met. Students receive credit balance checks within 14 days of receipt of funds.
