WHO WE ARE

The Summit Country Day School, founded in 1890, is a coeducational, Catholic, college prepatory school grounded in the values of our founders, the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur. Located on a 24-acre campus in Hyde Park, a residential area just five minutes from downtown Cincinnati, students hail from 38 different school districts in Ohio and Kentucky.

The school has a current enrollment of 1,073 students in a Montessori preschool and divisions through grade 12. The Upper School consists of 374 students and 46 highly trained teaching faculty. 62% of students are offered financial aid/scholarships.

Consistently ranked as one of the top high schools in Cincinnati, our mission is to develop leaders of character across five pillars: academic, athletic, social, spiritual and artistic. Our diverse student body excels at a wealth of enrichment activities including, but not limited to, leadership teams, clubs, competitive athletics, the arts, Christian Service, student broadcasting, Mock Trial, Robotics, philanthropy, ministry, and diversity.

POLICY ON THE REPORTING OF DISCIPLINARY ACTION




ACADEMIC CURRICULUM

- The Summit operates on a traditional semester system the school day has five 65-minute bells; each class meets three times a week
- Students must take six full credit/full bell courses each semester
- Class scheduling does not permit students to enroll in all courses for which they are eligible
- Students enrolled in AP courses are required to take the AP Exam; students very rarely take AP courses before sophomore year
- ♦ The Summit does not rank students, a result of our small class size and the considerable percentage of high academic achievers

CLASS OF 2025 ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS AND OUTCOMES

- 7% of the class was recognized by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation
- 92% of students in the Class of 2025 took at least one AP course
- 47 total AP Scholar Awards incluing 13 Scholars, 6 Scholars with Honor, and 28 Scholars with Distinction
- 86 seniors submitted applications to 136 unique colleges
- Graduates are attending 46 colleges in 20 states, the District of Columbia, and abroad
- 60% of graduates are attending public colleges and universities, 40% attending private

LEADERS OF CHARACTER

The Leaders of Character program is built upon three domains, developing self, building community, and serving God and has components that are required of all students. These include activities that are a part of our Advisement program, Gathering Bells, and our curriculum. Additional leadership opportunities are available to students including leadership teams, and faculty and student led organizations and clubs. These teams, organizations, and clubs share a common leadership curriculum that reflects our three domains and the attributes that define them. All students are encouraged to pursue what they enjoy, to try new activities, and then to work at being leaders in things for which they feel passionate.



WRITING SKILLS

Upon graduation, Summit students will have been successfully challenged to write a variety styles with vigor. Students write across the disciplines and will have competed five research papers at the end of their Summit tenure. 89 percent of our college-age alumni rank their writing ability higher than their college peers.
