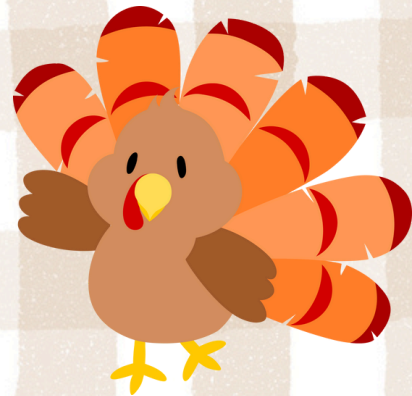

## STEAM

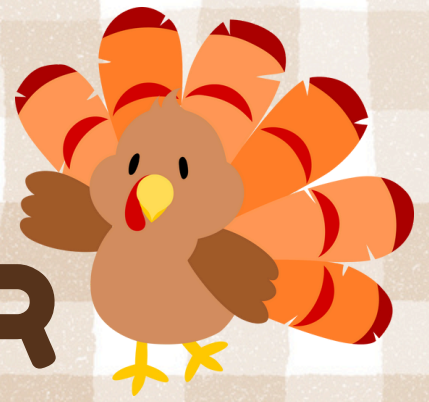
The STEAM scholars are busy learning about the engineering design process by creating paper airplanes and solving puzzles. We need tissues. Thank you!
