

# Middle School Pathway Exploration Policy Superintendent Attestation Form

The career technical education (CTE) regulations at 603 CMR 4.03(6)(i), amended by the Massachusetts Board of Elementary and Secondary Education in May 2025, require that districts maintain a districtwide Middle School Pathway Exploration Policy and submit it to DESE by November 1, 2025, and as amended. The Middle School Pathway Exploration Policy documents how middle school students in the district are made aware of and gain exposure to CTE schools and programs available to them in their district, regional, agricultural, and other public high schools. The CTE regulations also require that districts sign an annual attestation that their Middle School Exploration Policy is implemented. Districts must comply with federal and state law, including laws addressing discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, immigration or citizenship status, sex, gender identity, sexual orientation, religion, or disability.
