



## 2025-26 Advanced Placement Exam Registration Information

Taking the Advanced Placement exams is an important part of all AP courses. Friendswood High School desires that all students take AP exams for the AP classes that they have taken. Scoring well on an AP exam can often earn students college credit for their high school class, saving a significant amount on tuition. Use this tool, [AP Credit Policy Search](#), to find colleges that offer credit or placement for AP scores.

Please follow the steps below to register for the 2026 AP exams.

**Online Exam Registration will begin on Monday, September 8, 2025 at 6:00 AM and end on Friday, November 7, 2025 at 11:59 PM**

The AP exam registration process is **TWO steps**. We recommend that the student and parent/guardian do this together. ***Both must be completed in order to have AP exams ordered:***

### Step 1: Register and Pay for the AP exam(s)

Register at [www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/442625](http://www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/442625)

Indicate the AP courses you are taking this year **and** the exams you wish to take.

Receive your **join codes (you should have already completed this step in your AP class)** and directions to complete the second required step.

The cost is \$105 per exam. Students who qualify for a fee reduction will pay \$21. *In order to qualify for a fee reduction, families must complete or update the "free/reduced meals application" with the Food Services dept. before registering for AP exams.*

Exam fees may be paid online or with a check made out to Total Registration.

All payments must be made in full no later than **November 7, 2025 at 11:59 PM** in order for the exam(s) to be ordered.

**Ordering Exams Late** (after November 7, 2025 at 11:59 PM): Exams for year-long courses ordered after November 7 will incur a \$40 late fee.

**Canceled Exam Fees:** Exams can be canceled through Total Registration no later than Friday, March 13, 2026 at 11:59 PM and you will receive a refund for your exam, minus the \$40 cancellation fee.

### Step 2: AP Classroom Confirmation

Login to your **College Board** account at [myap.collegeboard.org](http://myap.collegeboard.org) to confirm that you have joined AP classroom (you will use the **join codes** provided by your teacher)

**LAST and MOST IMPORTANT STEP- Make sure to indicate "YES" under the Student Exam Decision Indicator; the default is "YES"**
