2025 Marathon Results

Sunset had 150 students finish the marathon this year compared to 70 finishers in 2024.

Kindergarten had the most finishers of all grade levels.

Ms. Patterson's first grade had 100% of her students finish the marathon.




Help from the Reading Coach



How Do I Help My Child Read Words They Don't Know?

1. If your child reads a word incorrectly or skips a word say, "Check it."
2. Let your child try to problem solve.

What is that word? I can problem solve!		
Look at the word from left to right.		Use your eyes to look at the word.
Slide each sound.		Slide the sounds together.
Try a different sound. • "Flex" the vowel.		Use a different vowel sound - a,e,i,o,u.
Break the word into parts.		cl ap s
Check it! • Does it make sense? • Does it sound right?		Look, listen and think about it.
Reread		Repeat

3. If he/she reads the word correctly, say:

"Yes, that word is _____. What word?"

(Child repeats the word.) Then say,

"Please reread the sentence."

If he/she still does not know the word, say:

"That word is _____. What word?"

(Child repeats the word.) Then say,

"Please reread the sentence."
