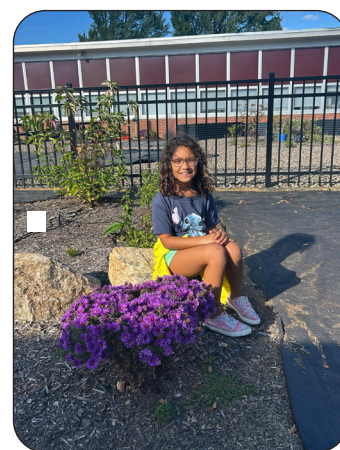

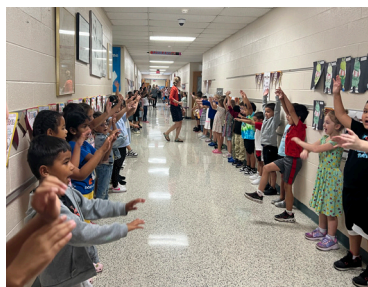

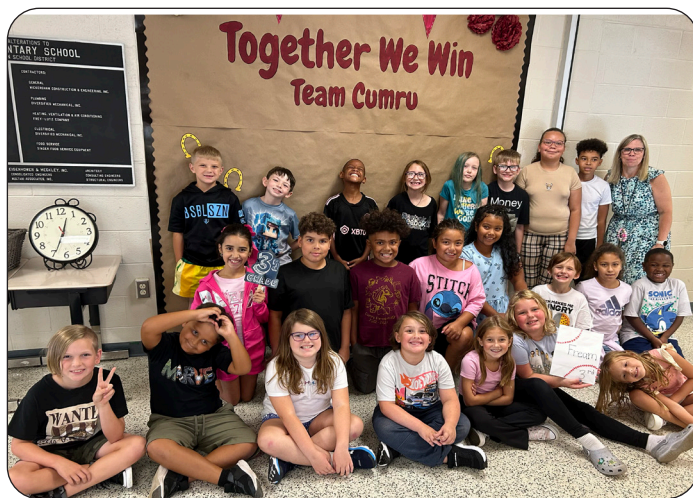
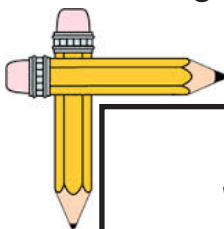
We are 2nd Grade. Yes, It's True.
